April FAQ Courses and Being a DM Teacher

Rather than do a Hints and Tips this month, I'm going to answer 2 of the most FAQ

Question 1 Which Courses?

Here is a quick summary of the courses I attended.

The Breakthrough Exp.

A few people are assuming that I took to everything easily, so I thought I would share my experiences of Demartini and specifically the B.E with you, to break a few of those fantasies, where you believe that you haven't got it quite right.

1) San Francisco

Oh dear! I certainly appreciated the DM, but I struggled big time.

In 'those days', of smaller courses, Dr D had a habit of 'picking' on 1 person who needed a bit of a kick; I was that person and I really wanted to throw things at him! I came to understand he had 2 objectives in this strategy:

- If they were struggling with a big issue, they were likely to gain a greater transformation
- It would reduce the amount of infatuation for him in the room.

Also, most people who decide to study with Dr D, do tend to have one course where he reflects back to them all sorts of stuff that they dislike about themselves. I just got mine over and done with earlier!

I did my Mum's alcoholism, and it had an extraordinary effect. A couple of weeks later she phoned me to discuss whether the combination of the gin at lunch time, brandy at 6pm and scotch at 8pm, might be conflicting and causing a bad emotional reaction in her. If you know of anything about alcoholics, this is quite an amazing thing for them to discuss. I know that when my Mum died a couple of years later, she knew that there was 1 person in her life who loved her just as she was.

2) Madrid

This was fascinating. My first finished at 11pm, this one finished at 4am! I learnt what a restriction religion and culture can be for people; they loved

their passionate stories and did not want to give them up.

At this one I did my husband, and from then on it felt like if I ever thought of him, he was actually there inside me at my heart (mind you, I have had to do a few more since then, as partners are a constant work in progress!).

3) Barcelona

This was the first one I attended that had an assistant, so it had got up to 60 people on it (small change nowadays). This was a mix of different cultures & finished much earlier than (2), which shows why we need all the different cultures to balance each other out.

I did my Dad who had passed away when I was 20. It was a most mysterious process, as the guy before me at the end seemed to disappear and my Dad's eyes appeared. All sense of separation from Dad was cleared, a great gift.

4) Denver

This was the 2nd one with my husband (he came to 1st as well). We had decided to get on a plane when my inability to have children came to a head, and you all know the miraculous result of that one, my little red headed monster!

5) Edinburgh

So this was weird being pregnant. I got picked several times and got messages from my unborn child. I did myself, and found it lovely to truly love a bit of me just as I am. Definitely the first step in becoming a Mum.

6,7,8) Assisting in London, and Dublin

Weirdly these have been just as transformational. It must be the opportunity to help all those people to open their hearts. Each one has clarified my mission massively.

Relationships

My favourite, and the one that I have studied and applied to my life most deeply. It is amazing how 2 days can actually be very complex when you start trying to 'walk your talk'.

Master Planning for Life

I still have loads of material from this one to work through. I learnt a big lesson from this one 'Be careful what you wish for'. I glibly wrote all sorts of things and did not think of the

consequences at all. Be warned, you WILL manifest from this course!

Certification

I loved the practicality of this course and the improvement in my ability to use the DM myself.

Prophecy

Again, I was pregnant, the greatest shift for me was finance day. Definitely, a worthwhile course. I understand what he means, because as you learn the laws of the universe, you can 'prophecy' what is going to happen in a given situation. Bizarrely I did this after Emphyreance – the wrong way around, it was the only way we could do it.

Emphyreance

10 days, 12hrs per day, 144 hours in total. It is hard work, and a bit like an initiation. I came out of it with deep esoteric knowledge, and a KNOWING that the universe is beautifully and magnificently organized, versus a belief.

Most Demartini teachers/coaches, mix and dilute it with something else, or have two jobs, and are a great deal more financially successful. It is possible that my strategy is a long term one, that win out in the end, but in the meantime, it is not as financially successful as my career in IT was!

Yes, I am married and have a beautiful baby boy, but those things came from applying the DM to my life, and it was at times very hard work. We nearly lost each other, and I lost friends, and clients.

Until recently I had very few people I could talk 'Demartini' to in the UK, and relied on MSN.

Nothing is ever missing, so all the things that I have listed as 'missing', were of course balanced out by something else. But it is important that you understand the journey that you might be about to embark upon. From my certification course, many people found that their destiny actually pointed elsewhere, in a new business, book or something equally as creative. It was the training that was the catalyst, but not everyone makes it to be a teacher. Nowadays with the creation of 4 levels, this will be much easier, as there is the interim option of coach. (Of course, this will create confusion as well!)

I LOVE my work, and would have it no other way, but it has been no bed of roses. Yes, I am the first certified DM teacher, and that is a type of success. I have both success and lack of success in my life. Just as you do.

I thoroughly recommend training with Dr D, but encourage you to keep your eyes open to the opportunities that will be presented, rather than assuming how it will all pan out.
